The Ukraine Centre in Cheetham Hill are now accepting donations in kind. They only need specific items which are listed as follows:

MEDICAL ITEMS (In Date)

- First aid kits; Field bandages; Cold/Flu treatment; Antiseptic cream
- Bandages; Sterile dressings; Wound closure strips; Antiseptic body wipes
- Emergency foil blankets; Surgical tape; Multivitamins; Cough syrup; Vicks Vapour rub; Barrier cream

TOILETRIES - Wet wipes; Pocket tissues; Pampers; Sanitary towels & Tampons

CLOTHING - ONLY THE FOLLOWING IS NEEDED:

- New Thermal vests/pants; Balaclavas; Shoe inserts; Hand and feet warmers
- Opaque tights for warmth for men and women (large size)
- Snoods (care with colour); Fingerless mittens.
