Grant for Salford Cathedral Music

Salford Cathedral has been awarded a £16,000 grant towards its Music Foundation from the Cathedral Music Trust.

The grant will be used to support our choral scholarships over the next year as well as investing in new sheet music as we continue to diversify our range of choral music.

As well as much needed financial support, the grant is a note of confidence in support of the musical renaissance we have seen in the Cathedral over the past two years. Out of the 22 grants awarded from the Trust, the only other two Catholic Cathedrals were Arundel and Westminster.

The grant will also enable us to expand our work in providing tuition for children and young people on the piano and organ and we're looking forward to announcing more details about this exciting innovation in the coming months.

To celebrate this 40th anniversary, on Tuesday 31 May 2022 at 7pm there will be a Mass in Our Lady of Grace church, Prestwich, M25 1AS - the parish in which the Mass in Heaton Park took place.

was one of the twelve priests ordained in the park,
and will be the main celebrant, accompanied by
