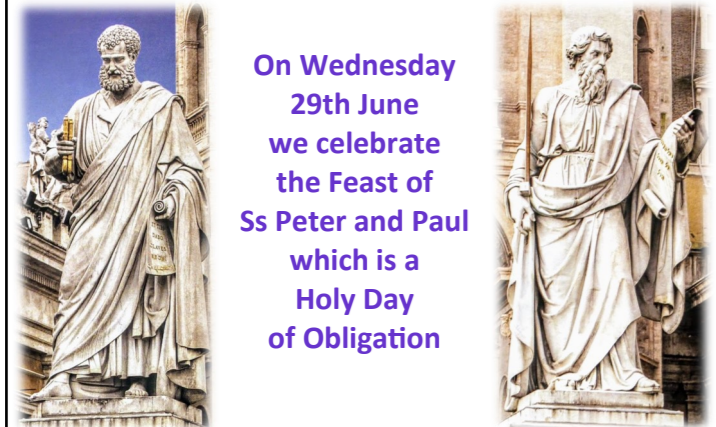

Information boards showing the proposed interior of will be present. This is a great chance to get a first look at the plans. The boards will remain in place for a week or two afterwards, to make sure everyone is able to see them.

Parish Response to Ukraine Crisis

The Ukraine Centre in Cheetham Hill are now accepting donations in kind. They only need specific items which are listed as follows:

MEDICAL ITEMS (In Date)

- **First aid kits; Field bandages; Cold/Flu treatment; Antiseptic cream**
- **Bandages; Sterile dressings; Wound closure strips; Antiseptic body wipes**
- **Emergency foil blankets; Surgical tape; Multivitamins; Cough syrup;**
- Vicks Vapour rub; Barrier cream**

TOILETRIES - Wet wipes; Pocket tissues; Pampers; Sanitary towels & Tampons

CLOTHING - ONLY THE FOLLOWING IS NEEDED:

- **New Thermal vests/pants; Balaclavas; Shoe inserts; Hand and feet warmers**
- **Opaque tights for warmth for men and women (large size)**
- **Snoods (care with colour); Fingerless mittens.**
