Salford Cathedral Music Foundation exists to provide opportunities to develop the musical potential of the children, young people, and adults of Salford, from all backgrounds, through active participation in the Cathedral's sung liturgies.

Led by our Director of Music, Alex Patterson, the Music Foundation was established in September 2020 with a grass-roots approach through the creation of our Children's Choir. A restructuring of our Cathedral Choir and Choral Scholarships, as well as a grant from the Cathedral Music Trust, has seen the musical life of the Cathedral transformed. We now also boast a thriving Girls' Choir and a specific group for boys with changing voices, our Cambiata Boys' Choir, providing progression routes for all our young people to develop their potential through music.

Recent highlights have included live broadcasts of our Cathedral Choir on BBC Radio 4 for Midnight Mass and Sunday Worship, a new CD of music by contemporary women composers released on Priory Records, and, for our teenage singers, a performance of Elgar's 'The Dream of Gerontius' as part of Gabrieli ROAR, and Mahler's Symphony No. 3 at the Bridgewater Hall.



We need your support as we aspire to be responsible custodians of this choral heritage.
