First Holy Communion Programme 2024-2025

Dear Parents

In the new School year, beginning September 2024, children of our Parish who will the be in year three and above, including those attending state-schools, will be eligible to enroll in preparation programme for their first reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Communion.

I am sure you will realise that we can only receive Holy Communion if we are <u>baptised Catholics</u>. Sometimes parents have delayed, for one reason or another, to have their child/children baptised. If a child is to be baptised there are special instructions to prepare both the child and parents as to its meaning and responsibilities in the eyes of God and the Church.

Without baptism a child will not be eligible to enter the Programme of preparation for Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist. Do not worry - this has been anticipated in the timetable of the programme which is now proposed.

On Saturday, 21st September at 11.00 am in the Assembly Room, Cathedral House, Chapel Street, there will be a meeting during which the parish catechists will explain how the Programme will work and give you details about the enrolment process for this year.

After this meeting, you will then have the time to make the decision as to whether you wish to enroll your child on the programme this year or not. If you wish to enroll your child, you will need to register on the weekend of the 5th and 6th October.


If your child requires the Sacrament of Baptism, special instructions will then take place from 12th of October to the 9th of November. This will prepare them for the First Communion Programme which will begin on the 16th of November.
