November—The Month of the Holy Souls

The month of November is the time in the Church's liturgical calendar, when we remember in a very special way, all those who have died. The names of all those we wish to pray for will be placed in a box in front of the Altar throughout the month of November.

Sacrament of Confirmation for Year 8 Children

The children of our parish community who are currently in Year 8 at High School are now invited to prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in May 2025. The parishes in the Salford Deanery have worked together to develop a 7-unit programme to help with preparation.

The programme has been designed and will be led by Sister Anna Yeo FDC, who is employed by the Deanery to coordinate its Confirmation programme and youth ministry in general. In addition to taking part in this 7-unit programme, candidates will be expected to attend Sunday Mass and take part in parish life as they grow in their understanding of the faith. Parents and Guardians can now register their children for the programme, which is required in order to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation next year.


Be Still and Know that I am God, 21st - 24th November 2024
