
We invite you to come along and try this form of prayer which is simple and peaceful.

Palestrina 500 - Choral Workshop Day

Saturday 1 February 2025, 10am - 5pm Cathedral House, 250 Chapel Street, Salford M3 5LE

Join Salford Cathedral Choir for a choral workshop day exploring the sacred music of Italian composer Giovanni Pierluigi da Palestrina - 500 years after his birth.

Led by Director of Music, Alex Patterson, the workshop will be an engaging deep dive into the music of one of the master's of renaissance polyphony, focusing on choral gems such as 'Sicut Cervus', 'Exsultate Deo', and the intricately beautiful 'Missa Papae Marcelli'.

The workshop will run from 10am - 5pm with breaks throughout the day. All sheet music will be provided on the day and available digitally beforehand. Participants will need to have a reasonable sight reading ability in order to get the most out of the day.
