## SALFORD CATHEDRAL Designated Jubilee Year Church Obtaining a Plenary Indulgence

The Year of Jubilee 2025 offers the opportunity to obtain a Plenary Indulgence - a special grace that strengthens our wounded souls in the fight against sin. Plenary Indulgences can also be obtained on behalf of our loved ones who have died, with the possibility of obtaining two plenary indulgences in one day, when one is on behalf of someone who has died.

### Conditions to obtain an indulgence are:

- 1) Be resolved to avoid sin and live in a spirit of charity
- 2) Go to confession
- 3) Receive the Holy Eucharist
- 4) Pray for the intentions of the Pope

The Indulgence can be obtained by undertaking a pilgrimage here to the Cathedral temporary church or any designated Jubilee site in the Diocese and beyond, observing the conditions listed above. Those unable to attend here - including people who are sick, have accessibility needs, or are in prison - can also receive an Indulgence wherever they are by reciting the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any approved form, and other prayers associated with the Holy Year.

## Project Thanksgiving

## Parish Pilgrimage to Medjugorje 24<sup>th</sup> -30<sup>th</sup> October 2025

Pilgrimage to Medjugorje, a small village nestled in the picturesque hills of Bosnia-Herzegovina, has been taking place since the 1980's when six local children reported visions of Our Lady.

Since then, Medjugorje has captured the hearts of millions worldwide. A place that has been described as a culture of miracles and an atmosphere of a thickness of deep peace, with countless upon countless of fruits coming from Medjugorje, including the children's charity 'Mary's Meals'.

This October half-term, the Cathedral Parish are organising a pilgrimage to Medjugorje for parishioners and families from 24<sup>th</sup> - 30<sup>th</sup> October with return flights from Manchester. For this pilgrimage to Medjugorje, the cost will include - flights, transfer from Split airport, hotel accommodation, diner and breakfast for 6 nights, local tour guide, all included for £730.00 per person.
