SALFORD CATHEDRAL Designated Jubilee Year Church Obtaining a Plenary Indulgence

The Year of Jubilee 2025 offers the opportunity to obtain a Plenary Indulgence - a special grace that strengthens our wounded souls in the fight against sin. Plenary Indulgences can also be obtained on behalf of our loved ones who have died, with the possibility of obtaining two plenary indulgences in one day, when one is on behalf of someone who has died.

Conditions to obtain an indulgence are:

- 1) Be resolved to avoid sin and live in a spirit of charity
- 2) Go to confession
- 3) Receive the Holy Eucharist
- 4) Pray for the intentions of the Pope

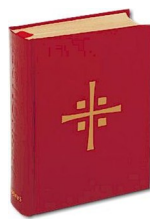
The Indulgence can be obtained by undertaking a pilgrimage here to the Cathedral temporary church or any designated Jubilee site in the Diocese and beyond, observing the conditions listed above. Those unable to attend here - including people who are sick, have accessibility needs, or are in prison - can also receive an Indulgence wherever they are by reciting the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any approved form, and other prayers associated with the Holy Year.

Synod Implementation Update

Our Diocese continues its journey of renewal and listening, begun by the Synod process. A Synod Implementation Team has been formed to guide the four key areas identified at our voting day in March. Each grouping of Leadership and Collaboration, Community and Outreach, Young People and Schools, and Spirituality and Formation, have their own dedicated subgroup.

As these teams begin their work, two recommendations are already developing.

The Community and Outreach group is recommending the establishment of Welcome Teams in every parish. Parishes are encouraged to share their good practice on Welcome and are asked to form Teams by the First Sunday of Advent.

Ideas and opinions are being gathered which may promote appropriate support structures for our clergy.

Let us continue to pray that we may discern what the Holy Spirit is saying to the Church, and to our Diocese, in these times.

Project Thanksgiving

The purpose of this project is to provide parishioners and supporters of Salford Cathedral, the opportunity to give thanks to Almighty God for the restoration of our beautiful cathedral and the many blessings which we will receive once the cathedral has re-opened in February 2026.

All the money raised through this appeal will go towards the restoration of the crucifix, previously located in the north transept, which will be re-hung at the entrance to the newly refurbished sanctuary. It will also cover the costs associated with the restoration of the image of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, the Pieta, St. Joseph, Sacred Heart, St. John the Evangelist, St. Therese of Lisieux and St. Anthony of Padua.

The details of the crucifix and the other statues to be restored and how you can donate towards their restoration can be found in the special booklet entitled **'Project Thanksgiving'**, which you will find at the back of the temporary church.

This is a wonderful opportunity for us, as a parish family, to contribute to the restoration of our church and so I encourage you to do so with love and generosity.
