Sorry for the inconvenience this may cause.

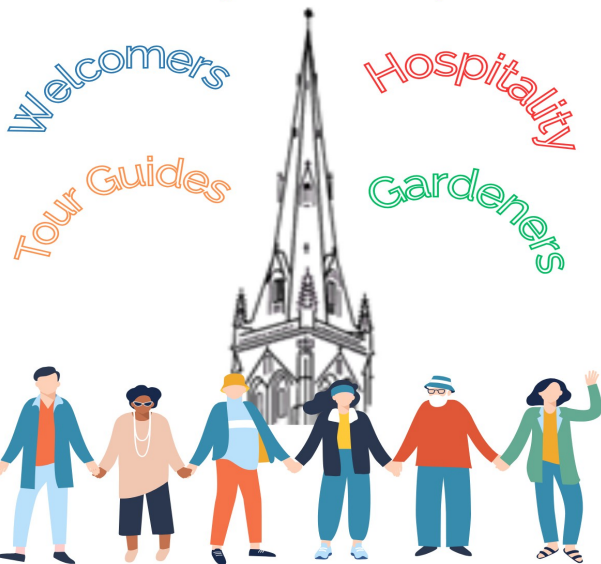

Deaf Awareness and Conversational British Sign Language Course

There are over 11 million people registered with a hearing loss in the UK today. This equates to one person in every six. Clinical Commissioning Groups document more than 12,500 British Sign Language users in the North West of England.

At Caritas, their Deaf Awareness and Conversational British Sign Language (BSL) course is for adult parishioners across the diocese. This 12-week programme will equip participants with basic BSL skills and greater awareness of accessibility and inclusion in parish life.

Participants will:

- Learn to hold simple conversations in BSL, introduce themselves, and discuss parish roles.
- Ask and answer questions about time, dates, and events.
- Describe people, places, and emotions.
- Understand and use signs relevant to parish life (clergy, Mass, sacraments, refreshments, directions).
- Navigate church spaces using BSL spatial grammar.
- Gain real-life practice with invited Catholic Deaf guests.
- Develop awareness of accessibility needs and inclusive pastoral practice.
- Foster a culture of mutual respect, shared belonging and greater accessibility.

A certificate will be awarded for 75 per cent attendance.
