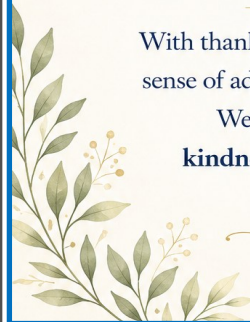
Cathedral reopens.

Vacancies - Teaching and Learning Delivery Support

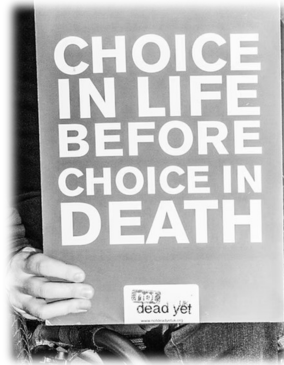
