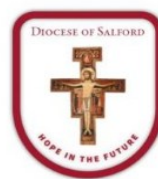

St Mary's RC Cemetery Bank Holiday Mass (Amendment)

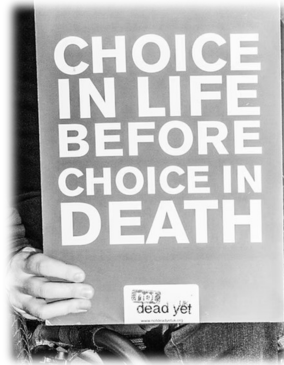
This annual Mass will take place on Monday 31 August at 11AM at St Mary's Cemetery, Wardley. It will be held outside the Chapel and there will be limited seating.
